Judge's Comments

Junior Puppy Male

- 1st ELKOMAC'S THE DIPLOMAT (Enright and Mills). A very nice eight months light red with well boned straight legs, good front, good spring of rib, broad right through to the rear, not falling away behind the rib cage. Good tail set. Good masculine head with broad muzzle of right length. Well filled cut broad skull, clear eyes. Ears could be smaller, but too small would not look right with this type of head. Moved a little sloppily but this will tighten with age, and needs to grow on to really complete the picture; he has the time. Reserve Winners Dog.
- 2nd ALDE BEAR HUSTLER (Stamm and Murray). Six months red. Good body and bone, a nice cobby build, with good tail set. Strong masculine head not quite as good in muzzle as the winner.
- 3rd KIALIN HUGGY BEAR (Guy). Shining black, 6 months old on the day. Taller than 1 and 2, good bone, nice make and shape, dark clean eyes, well carried ears. Being bigger needs more time to body up to complete the picture.

Senior Puppy Male

- 1st T'AN YV'S PEPI (McCardee). Eleven months red. Upstanding, with masculine outlook, clean dark eyes, well boned straight legs, good reach of neck, in between coats which did not help the overall picture. Action did not appeal but will probably tighten with age.

Canadian Bred Male

- 1st SANGATE THE BU DYNASTY BOY (Melega). Self red, with shorter coat. Pleasing masculine head and expression, adequate bone, nicely built, good tail set. Eyes could be smaller and action better.

Open Dog Red

- 1st WAH HU'S SUGAR DADDY (Coogan). Cobby self red of the type I like, evenly well balanced body with well boned legs, neat feet. Masculine head with broad muzzle, without overdone wrinkles, neat

well-set ears, dark eyes, good rib cage, well filled out over the hindquarters, very good pigmentation, moved and showed well. Reminded me very much of Champions Russ Kandy and Brensteven of Briercliffe. Winners Dog and Best of Winners.

2nd MINGODELLS CASEY'S SUNNY BOY (Mills). Typy, cobby, short coupled red, not as well boned as winner and rather finer all through. Masculine outlook of a different type but a good overall picture except I was not too happy about his colour.

3rd STARCREST MR FAT ALBERT (Hendrix). A much bigger dog with very profuse coat. To me this type of coat hides the skull and it is difficult to really assess the head to its full advantage. Not as good front, but back level with good tail set. Adequate bone.

Junior Puppy Bitch

1st ELKOMAC MERRY ENCHANTRESS (Henderson and Enright). Eight months red. Litter sister to Reserve Winners Dog, but needs more time to mature. Pleasing feminine head and expression with neat ears, well bodied, good tail set, adequate bone.

2nd CEDAR CREEK'S SPUNKY TAR (Brodeurs). A very typy little black seven months old, short coupled, good tail set, nice feminine head. Needs to grow which she has time to do. Ears were flying all the time.

Bred by Exhibitor Bitch

1st BU DYNASTY THE MISCHIEF MAKER (Peddie and Williams). Good type red, feminine head with good skull, dark eyes, nice front, level back wit- good tail set. Straight bone. Moved well. Reserve Winners Bitch.

Open Red Bitch

1st EDLEN LARISSA (Enright). A good type red, nicely boned, good muzzle and skull, dark eyes, good front and rib cage, well balanced, good tail set. Good mover. Winners Bitch.

2nd BU DYNASTY MY ROYAL CRYSTAL (Burk). Similar type to winner, but not quite as good in head or bone. Well presented.

3rd INDIAN SUMMER MINGODELL (Mills). Not my type at all. Heavy head with ultra short muzzle, very profuse coat, good bone, needs more length of leg.

Best of Breed

CH. HSI WANGS SONG SUMI (Russell). Lovely self-red bitch, really good head with feminine outlook, good muzzle, clean dark eyes, neat well placed ears, good front and rib cage. Head well set on good shoulders. Good brisket and hindquarters. Well boned legs, neat feet, good tail set. Well presented. Showed and moved well. Wish she were mine.

Best of Opposite Sex

CH. MI-PAOS BRIGADIER (Odenkirchen). Superbly boned light red dog with very good masculine outlook, well filled out around the eyes, good skull. Broad front, well boned legs, neat feet, good strength in body, tail carried well over the back. Superb showman in lovely coat. Preferred ears of winner, and maybe he could be a bit bigger for a dog.

I found the standard of handling much higher than in the U.K. None took a dislike to me. Coats were pleasant to handle. Pigmentation was much better than in U.K. where it is not as good in the reds as it should be. Mouths were good. There was a greater divergence of type than we would see and also of size, even though the consensus of opinion seems to be that ours are getting smaller. In my top winners I found the type of chow which seems to me to more closely conform to the Breed Standard, without the ultra short wrinkled muzzles and long profuse coats. The latter seems to me to detract from what should be at first sight a powerfully built impressive dog, or powerfully built, more kindly expressioned bitch. To assess movement I do not care to move them around the ring as I do not consider chows give of their best when moved this way. Rear movement in general was as bad as it is in the U.K. My thanks for giving me the opportunity to go over your chows, and for thinking such a long journey worth while.
