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Nomination Guidelines

(from the CCCC Policies and Procedures 2023)

2.3 Nominations

No person may be a candidate in a Club election who has not been nominated in accordance with the Bylaws.

- 2.3.1** A Nominating Chairperson shall be chosen by the Board of Directors. The Chairperson may select a committee to assist, of which all members must be in good standing, with no more than one being a member of the current Board of Directors. Business may be conducted by mail or by other electronic means.
- 2.3.2** The Chairperson, with the help of the committee (if one selected) shall nominate from among the eligible members of the Club, one candidate for each official office and three (3) elected director positions, and shall procure the acceptance of each nominee so chosen. Candidates shall not be nominated for more than one office or position, and only one member of a family may be nominated. The Chairperson shall then submit a slate of candidates to the Executive Secretary and the President. This list, including the full name of each candidate and the name of the province and region in which they reside, will be provided to each member of the Club on or before October 7th so that additional nominations may be made by the members if they so desire.
- 2.3.3** Additional nomination of eligible members who are not family members of the slate of candidates may be made by written petition, addressed to the Executive Secretary and President, on or before October 31st and must be accompanied by the signature of the nominator(s) and written acceptance of each such additional nominee signifying their willingness to be a candidate.
- 2.3.4** If the Executive Secretary or President receives no additional valid nominations on or before October 31st, the Nominating Chairperson's slate shall be declared elected and no balloting will be required.
- 2.3.5** If one or more valid additional nominations are received by the Executive Secretary or the President on or before October 31st, the Elections Officer shall be directed to mail to each voting Club member in good standing, to their address on record (i.e. no "care/of" addresses), a ballot listing all of the nominees for each position in alphabetical order, with the names of the province or region in which they reside, together with a blank envelope or a return envelope addressed to the Elections Officer marked "Ballot" and bearing the name of the member to whom it was sent. So that the ballots may remain secret, each voter, after making their ballot, shall seal the ballot in the blank envelope that in turn shall be placed in the second envelope addressed to the Elections Officer. The Elections Officer shall check the returns against the list of members whose dues are paid for the current year prior to opening the outer envelopes and removing the blank envelope, and shall certify the eligibility of the voters as well as the results of the voting.
- 2.3.6** The Elections Officer shall notify the Executive Secretary and the President of the results of the voting, so that the results can be announced by written notification to all members.
- 2.3.7** Nominations cannot be made at the Annual General Meeting or in any manner other than as provided above.
- 2.3.8** According to CKC Rules and Regulations, at least four official regions must be represented by Directors.
